Clothing— Adult size S-2X t-shirts, shorts, pajamas, lightweight & winter jackets, black leggings, joggers, hoodies & sweatshirts; socks for infants, children & adults in all sizes

School Uniforms—khaki pants & hunter green polo short- & long-sleeve shirts in all child & adult sizes **Underwear**—white undershirts in all sizes for boys & men; boxer-briefs in all sizes for boys & men; female underwear in all sizes for girls & women; non-underwire bras+ in size 34-40 B-DD

Personal Care Items**—shampoo, body wash, solid deodorant, disposable razors, shaving cream, unscented lotion, facial tissue, hairbrushes, textured hair products, ponytail holders & hair clips Baby Care—diapers in all sizes, wipes, Pullups in sizes 2T-5T, baby wash, baby lotion, infant acetaminophen & ibuprofen, diaper rash ointment, small jars of Vaseline, digital thermometers, bottles & sippy cups, onesies in all sizes
